ISIAIAH "ZAY" FREEMAN OF NORRISTOWN BEING SOUGHT FOR FIRST-DEGREE MURDER OF JORDAN SCOTT ON JULY 6; \$1,000 REWARD OFFERED

Already in custody is William Durell Wilson, 30, of Norristown

THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE is offering a \$1,000 REWARD for information leading to the apprehension of ISIAIAH FREEMAN. Freeman is charged with the Homicide death of Jordan Scott who was shot on Thursday, July 6, 2017 in the Municipality of Norristown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. Freeman should be considered armed and dangerous.

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Aug. 29, 2017) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Norristown Police Chief Mark E. Talbot announce the charging of Isaiah Freeman, 18, and William Durell Wilson, 30, both of Norristown, with First-Degree Murder for the July 6 shooting death of 16-year-old Jordan Scott in Norristown.

An arrest warrant has been issued for Freeman, and the DA's Office is offering a \$1,000 reward for any information leading to his arrest. Freeman should be considered armed and dangerous. Wilson has been arrested and is in custody.

At 6:32 p.m., Thursday, July 6, 2017, Norristown Police responded to 623 Chain Street to find Scott suffering from multiple gunshot wounds and a second male victim suffering from a gunshot wound to the ankle. Scott was transported to Mercy Suburban Hospital, where he was pronounced dead at 7:28 p.m. The second male was treated at Paoli Hospital.

A joint investigation by the Montgomery County Detective Bureau and Norristown Municipal Police Department revealed that Wilson was driving a gray 2013 Dodge Charger with Freeman in the passenger front seat when they saw the two victims walking in the vicinity of Oak and Chain streets. Wilson drove the vehicle around the corner and waited. When the two men walked by, Freeman opened fire from the corner of a building, striking both Scott and the second victim, whose identity is known to detectives.

Freeman and Williams are both charged with First-Degree Murder, Third-Degree Murder, Criminal Conspiracy, Aggravated Assault and related charges. Wilson was also charged with Unsworn Falsification to Authorities.

Wilson was arraigned Aug. 9, 2017, before Magisterial District Judge Greg Scott. No bail is available for First-Degree Murder charges, and Wilson was remanded to the Montgomery County Correctional Facility. Wilson's preliminary hearing is scheduled for 1 p.m., Sept. 7, 2017 before Judge Scott.
