One Montgomery Plaza Closed Due to a Power Outage

Norristown, PA (October 16, 2019) – Offices in One Montgomery County Plaza, Montgomery County’s office building at 425 Swede Street, will be closed through Thursday, Oct. 17th due to a power outage that is affecting the entire building.

An electrical contractor hired by the county is working to restore power to the building as quickly as possible. Departments that have offices in the building are implementing their continuity of operations plans and temporarily relocating personnel to other facilities.

The Montgomery County Commissioners meeting scheduled for 10 a.m. Thursday will be relocated to Courtroom A of the Montgomery County Court House.

One Montgomery Plaza, which is directly across Swede Street from the Montgomery County Court House, is the only county facility that is affected. We will provide updated information as it becomes available.

All offices in the building will be inaccessible to the public until power is restored, including the following offices that routinely receive visitors: Board of Assessment Appeals, County Commissioners, Court Care, Domestic Relations, Human Resources, Planning Commission, Recorder of Deeds, Register of Wills, Treasurer and Voter Services.
